## **BAPTISMS**

We have now started to arrange baptism ceremonies. We have a huge backlog of baptisms, going back several months due to the covid restrictions, and we will go through the applications in chronological order.

## **COLLECTION AT MASS ON TUESDAY - STS PETER AND PAUL**

On Tuesday we celebrate the solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. As is traditional, there will be a collection for 'Peter's Pence', to help the Pope and the Apostolic See exercise works of mercy, charity and its service to the Universal Church.

## **INSTALLATION OF A STREAMING CAMERA**

At this time we have employed a firm to install a fixed camera in the church so that we can continue to stream our daily 10am Mass without having to use an iPhone or iPad, and without having to use an earpiece microphone. We think it important for the privacy of parishioners to be respected and so the picture will not show parishioners coming up for Holy Communion. When the camera and technology is fully functioning we will continue to stream the Masses from this camera on our usual YouTube channel. This will become a permanent service in the future.

We would like to acknowledge the wonderful effort of Fr Krzysztof, supported when needed by Fr David and Fr Daniel, in setting up his iPhone every day for the past months since the covid restrictions, especially when the church had to be closed. This has been a devoted effort on his part to ensure that parishioners staying at home could join in with our daily Mass and continue to feel part of the family of St Saviour's. We thank him very much for all that he has done.

We know that the daily streaming of our 10am Mass has been very much appreciated by parishioners as we hear so many positive words of feedback

A parishioner had been asking and praying for this daily streaming even before covid came along. His prayers have been answered. Well done.

### SPIRITUAL THOUGHT FROM FR CHRIS

This Tuesday we celebrate the solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. Below are some of their words from the Bible to help us reflect on how to live a spiritual life with God.

#### From St Peter:

'Never pay back one wrong with another, or an angry word with another; instead pay back with a blessing.'

'Be sure, then, you are never spiteful, or deceitful, or hypocritical, or envious and critical of each other.'

'Do not behave in the way you liked to before you learnt the truth; make a habit of obedience: be holy in all you do, since it is the Holy One who has called you.'

'Wrap yourselves in humility to be servants of each other, because God refuses the proud and will always favour the humble. Bow down, then, before the power of God....Be calm but vigilant, because your enemy the devil is prowling round like a lion, looking for someone to eat. Stand up to him, strong in faith.'

'Add goodness to the faith that you have, understanding to your goodness, self-control to your understanding, patience to your self-control, true devotion to your patience, kindness towards your fellow men to your devotion, and to this kindness, love.'

#### From St Paul:

'You must not let sin reign in your mortal bodies or command your obedience to bodily passions, why you must not let any part of your body turn into an unholy weapon fighting on the side of sin; you should instead offer yourselves to God.....make every part of your body into a weapon fighting on the side of God.'

'Do not let your love be a pretence. but sincerely prefer good to evil....have a profound respect for each other....Do not give up if trials come; and keep on praying....and you should make hospitality your special care.'

'Treat everyone with equal kindness; never be condescending but make real friends with the poor. Do not allow yourselves to be self-satisfied. Never repay evil with evil but let everyone see that you are interested only in the highest ideals. Do all you can to live at peace with everyone.'

'Don't delude yourself into thinking God can be cheated; where a man sows, there he reaps: if he sows in the field of self-indulgence he will get a harvest of corruption out of it; if he sows in the field of the Spirit he will get from it a harvest of eternal life. We must never get tired of doing good.'
