SPIRITUAL THOUGHT FROM FR CHRIS

One of the saints remembered by the Church today is **St Robert of Molesme**. He was born in 1028 near Troyes in France. At the age of fifteen he entered the local Benedictine Abbey and rose to the office of prior. He later became abbot of another abbey, but found the monks there difficult to supervise. In 1074, St Robert was asked by some hermits to be their superior, which received approval from the Pope. In 1098, St Robert, and other monks, founded a monastery at Citeaux, near Dijon, France, with the goal of living strictly by the Rule of St Benedict. St Robert served as the first Abbot. He later returned to the abbey at Molesme, where he worked and prayed for the rest of his life. He died on 17 April 1111 and was canonised a saint by Pope Honorius III in 1222.
